

Daisy

Hook size 4mm

Yarn: Stylecraft Special DK in Candyfloss, Apricot, Clematis, White and Wisteria.

This pattern is written in US terms

US Terminology

SC – single crochet
HDC – half double crochet
DC – double crochet
FPDC - front post double crochet
BPDC - back post double crochet
SLST – slip stitch
MR – magic ring
CH – chain
ST - stitch
() – indicate all stitches to be made in one stitch.

UK Terms

TR

BPTR

Gauge is 19 stitches x 11 rows = 10cm (rows of DC).

Finished Square measures 12cm x 12cm.



Square

- Using **CANDY FLOSS** in MR, CH3 – *counts as a DC throughout pattern*. Then in ring make 2DC, CH2, (3DC, CH2) 3 times. CH2, and SLST in the 3rd ST of beginning CH3. (20 stitches, 4 clusters of 3DC).
- (CH3, **TURN** work, 2DC, CH2, 3DC) in the same space. (3DC, CH2, 3DC) in the next corner space. Repeat around finishing with SLST in top of the beginning CH3. (32 stitches, 8 clusters of 3DC).
- (CH3, **TURN** work, 2DC) in the same space. *(3DC, CH2, 3DC) in corner space. 3DC in between 3DC clusters from the previous row. Repeat * around finishing with a SLST in top of beginning CH3. (44 stitches, 12 clusters of 3DC).
- 4-6. Repeat row 3.
- (CH1 – *does not count as a ST throughout pattern*, **TURN**, SC), SC in each ST around with (2SC, CH2, 2SC) in corner spaces. Repeat around Finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC made. Fasten off yarn. (Each side has 22SC with CH2 in each corner).
- Join with **LEMON** yarn in any corner space. (CH1, 2SC, CH2, 2SC). * SC in each ST with (2SC, CH2, 2SC) in corner space. Repeat from * around. Finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC made to join. Fasten off yarn. (Each side has 26SC with CH2 in each corner).

Daisy Flower

- Using **LEMON** In MR, make 16DC. SLST in 1st DC to join. (16 Stitches).
- CH2, then *FPDC around the 1st DC, BPDC around next DC. Repeat from * around. SLST in top of the first FPDC to join. (16 stitches).
- (CH1, SC), SC in each ST around finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC. (*This will make the centre of the daisy rise up.*) Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail to sew flower onto square. (16 Stitches).
- Working in the **FRONT LOOPS** only of Row 3 - Join **WHITE** yarn in any ST. * CH8, then SC in the 2nd CH from hook and in the next 6 stitches down the chain. SLST into the next SC ST and repeat from * around finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC made to join. (16 petals made).
- CH1. Working in the **BACK LOOPS** only of **Row 3**. Push petals forward and work a SLST in the back loop of the 1st SC, * CH10. SC in the 2nd CH from the hook, HDC in the next 8 stitches down the chain. SLST into next SC and repeat from * around finishing with a SLST in the 1st SLST. (16 petals made). Fasten off yarn.
- Place Daisy in the centre of the square. Use the lemon long tail to sew the daisy onto the square. Only sew a round of stitches through Row 3 so that the petals will naturally curl up.
